JIM & GAIL WILBURN



Jim and Gail met on the Amazon River, while spending a week in the jungles high in the Peruvian Andes. Gail, having nurtured two children through college, had been at the White House assisting Barbara Bush with her correspondence during the Bush '41 years, and when she met Jim, he was working at Empower America as an assistant to William Bennett, Jack Kemp and Jeane Kirkpatrick. Jim, after stints as provost, vice president, and dean of the business school at Pepperdine, had gone to the Amazon to try to decide whether or not to come "out of retirement" to start the new School of Public Policy as its inaugural dean.

The first night on the rusty boat (that Jim nick-named "Son of African Queen"), with 30 passengers, Jim and Gail discovered that they had many mutual friends (Jim had invited long time friend Jack Kemp to help him start the School of Public Policy if he decided to be dean). Gail went home to help manage Empower America while Jack ran for vice-president of the United States, and Jim went home to Malibu and agreed to launch the School of Public Policy.

After a two year bi-coastal courtship, Jim convinced Gail, originally a New Yorker, to leave the East Coast where she had grown up and reared her family, to come help him build the new School of Public Policy, Pepperdine's newest of its four graduate schools, and they have been a genuine team in that effort. Gail has recently completed a Master's degree in Clinical Psychology/Marriage and Family Counseling and currently interns at the Southern California Counseling Center. The School of Public Policy will celebrate its tenth anniversary next fall with Governor Jeb Bush as its featured speaker.

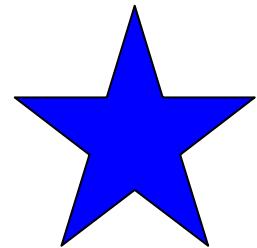

Immigration Update

Another amnesty bill has come back, this time in the House of Representatives. **HR 1645**, the Security through Regularized Immigration and a Vibrant Economy (STRIVE) Act was introduced in the House of Representatives by Rep. Jeff Flake (R-AR) and Luis Gutierrez (D-IL).

This bill is not just about selling-out America to the lowest foreign worker bidder. The end-game of **H.R. 1645** is the even more deadly: the sovereignty-eroding Security and Prosperity Partnership of North America (SPP) plan for regional government. www.spp.gov

H.R. 1645 is 697 pages of immigration give-always including at least seven types of amnesties great and small.

Here is the tally:

Section 401—new worker program;

Section 624—rolling amnesty for children under 16 years old;

Section 643—agricultural workers “blue card” amnesty;

Section 601—conditional non-immigrant worker program;

Section 722—illegal relatives of 9/11 victims amnesty;

Section 732—asylum free-for-all for “persecuted religious minority” applicants;

Section 733—“forestry” worker addition to the 1986 amnesty.

And there is an unbelievable standard of proof for the bill’s main illegal alien amnesty in “Title VI—Legalization of Undocumented Individuals.” Section 602(a) (4)—Adjustment of Status for Conditional Non-immigrants—explains that “it is the sense of the Congress that the requirement under this section should be interpreted and implemented in a manner that recognizes and takes into account the difficulties encountered by aliens in obtaining evidence of employment due to the undocumented status of the alien.”

With that kind of standard, **H.R. 1645** is a fraud magnet and an illegal alien-chasing immigration lawyer’s dream. Keep your eye on the Security and Prosperity Partnership of North America (SPP) plan.
