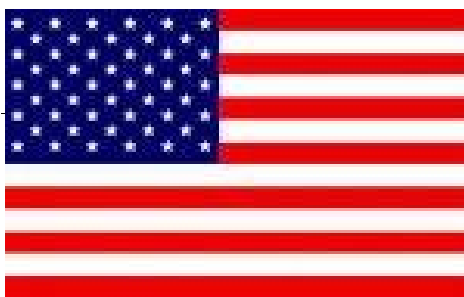
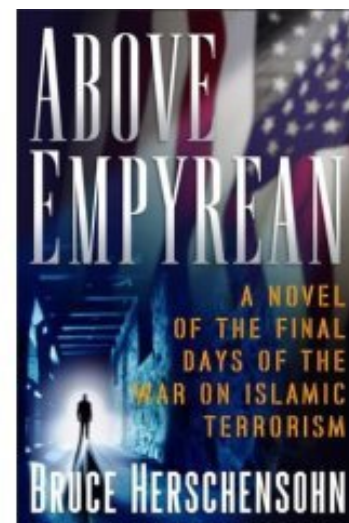
Bruce Herschensohn's New Book
