Congressman David Dreier Featured Speaker at Oct. Meeting

With a dose of both humor and candor, Congressman David Dreier addressed more than 100 attendees from Malibu/Bel-Air RWF, Westlake Village RWF and Pepperdine College Republicans at a luncheon meeting on October 24 at Dukes of Malibu.



Special quests Pat Weiss, President-elect of CFRW Southern Divi-

sion, plus John Clark Gable, son of



Clark Gable, and Robert Flutie, a candidate for Congress in the 30th District, were all introduced.

The Congressman expressed his dismay about the demise of trust in Congress, but was adamant about the importance of maintaining a two-party system, as opposed to hundreds of parties in many foreign countries.

Having traveled to Irag, Iran and Afghanistan, he is appreciative of America's system of government which emphasizes individual liberty. Due to falling approval ratings for the Obama Administration, he feels the Republican Party can make great strides in next year's elections if we
