Proposition 21: Adds \$18 annual vehicle license surcharge to increase funding for state parks and wildlife conservation

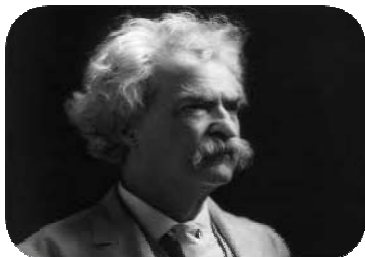
