PRODUCER, HUMANITARIAN, ACTIVIST

Pro-life activist Jason Jones will share his unique perspective as a movie producer, radio talk show host and political organizer on Wednesday, June 15.



Malibu/Bel-Air Republican Women Federated will host the event at Duke's Restaurant in Malibu. The cost is \$40 (payable in advance), and includes a buffet dinner.

Jones has been in politics and media throughout his career. In his progression from student activist, to staffer, to department director, to personality and to film producer, he has maintained a laser focus on defending the value of human life.

His most recent contribution to furthering a culture of life has been as a Hollywood producer.

Jones was executive producer on the critically acclaimed 2006 film "Bella." The film won the People's Choice Award at the 2006 Toronto Film Festival. He also has produced several documentaries, and served as associate producer of "Dead in the Water."

Jones hosted the syndicated *Facts of Life* radio show heard throughout the United States and worldwide. He has appeared on ABC's *Politically Incorrect*, EWTN, Fox and CNN.

Jones attended the University of Hawaii, where he formed the Pro-life Student Union and was chairman of the Hawaii Young Republicans. Upon graduation he worked as the chief of staff for Hawaii State Rep. Mark Moses, then served as director of Hawaii Right to Life. For three years, Jones was co-host of The Voice of the Majority with Rep. Moses, heard throughout the Hawaiian Islands on KWAJ-AM 1080. He was then recruited to be national youth director for the American Life League and later served as the public relations director for Human Life International, the world's largest international pro-life organization.

In 2004 he worked for the Republican National Committee and in

2006 he ran a get-out-the-vote campaign for Missouri's Say No to Amendment 2. In 2007, he was national grassroots director for Sam Brownback's presidential run. While working for then-Sen. Brownback, Jones organized, and spoke on the Pro-Life Whole tour.

In 2009, Jones traveled to Sudan, visiting refugees on the Darfur border and distributing \$2 million in food, medicine and other aid.

He is currently president and founder of Whole Life America, a non-profit organization that promotes the dignity of the human person.

UCLA DISMISSAL UPDATE
ENSTROM WAITS FOR HEARING DECISION

UCLA epidemiologist James Enstrom is waiting for a decision this month that may reverse his firing for what some call politically incorrect research.

After 36 years at the university, Enstrom was told that he would not be rehired because his research "is not aligned" with the university's academic mission. But the timing coincided with Enstrom's conflict with the California Air Resources Board (CARB) and its new diesel emissions standards.

Enstrom appealed the decision and was granted a hearing April 4-8. "I have made a very strong case for reappointment," he said. The hearing officer's decision is due before July 1, then the UCLA chancellor will make the final decision.



With a concern about academic freedom and scientific integrity, the Foundation for Individual Rights in Education (FIRE) helped Enstrom at the hearing and with post-hearing briefs.

In 2008, the non-tenured professor's research found no causal link between diesel emissions and early death. Not only did Enstrom question the science behind CARB's new standards, he exposed one of its researcher's faked doctorate and term limit violations on the board.

Those embarrassing revelations drew scrutiny to the board at a time when it's imposing an estimated \$5.5 billion in new emissions standards on the California trucking industry.

(Enstrom is the husband of one of MBA-RWF's longtime members, Judge Marta Enstrom.)

36TH DISTRICT RUNOFF

A July runoff will determine the next representative in Congress for the South Bay. In a major upset, Republican businessman Craig Huey is facing Democrat Los Angeles City Councilwoman Janice Hahn on Tuesday, July 12.

The left-leaning 36th district covers Redondo Beach, Manhattan Beach, Torrance, El Segundo, Venice, Wilmington and San Pedro. Democrat Jane Harmon represented the district until her February resignation to take another job.

Sixteen candidates ran for the seat in a May primary. Under new rules, voters could choose from among many more names, regardless of party. Democrats dominated the slate, which also split their votes. Huey was the beneficiary.

Huey finished in second place with 22.2% of the vote. Hahn won with 24.6% of the vote and ahead of the expected contender, California's Secretary of State Debra Bowen, who garnered 21%.

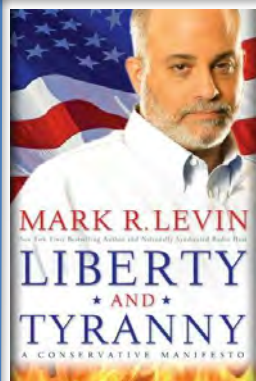
